## SCHOOL HISTORY

There came a time in our history when the school system in Liberia could not accommodate the learning needs of the increasing student's population as a result of the civil crisis. During that period, many people in rural Liberia then referred to as "Greater Liberia" to seek refuge in Monrovia then referred to by the ECOMOG as safe heaven.

In addition to the above, a large number of Liberian returned from Sierra Leone in 1991 as a result of the rebel incursion in that country. Thus, making the situation more difficult. Among those who had the plight of the children at heart were Deacon Pedro G. Cole, Pastor D. Gaylah Colkahn and the Matadi Baptist Church Family. Owing to the lack of sound Christian school within the Matadi Community at the time pastor Colkahn together with the Matadi Baptist Church deemed it necessary to have one opened for the children of their church and the children of Matadi Community. After series of discussion, a study class was established in 1994.

The performance of the staff in the study class proved excellent and it was upgraded to an elementary school, later junior high and now a senior high school named in memory of Edward Kenneth Mol, a Christian Businessman whose family was instrumental in making the dream of the Matadi Baptist Church family a reality (May his soul rest in peace). Since the establishment of the school, it has graduated over 1000 students from the Kindergarten Division and over 500 from Junior and Senior High Divisions.
